

# Getting to Know Each Other

I have always found it difficult to get to know other people. I tend to be shy and quiet. I don't want to intrude, be pushy or nosy, or make others uncomfortable. I also



tend to assume that if people want my presence, they will invite me. And yet, I've learned that's not always or even often the case.

As I settle into my role as Pastor, I want you to know that I really and truly want to get to know each member of Edgewood, each of you. If you weren't sure about that, it is most likely a result of my shyness and social awkwardness. I do want to know you, and for you to know me... I'm just not very good at making that happen. So, I ask for grace and patience. I also would ask that you invite me to visit, to have lunch or dinner with your family, to go for a walk (once it's warmer), to watch a little league game, to sit and knit... And you are always welcome to visit me in my study. (I now have a comfy couch!) I'd love to talk to you about anything or everything! Though, I'll likely be awkward with small talk.

If you are sick, having surgery, dealing with struggles, or just because, I am here to support you, to remind you of God's love and grace, to pray for and with you, and to just be with you. Edgewood is a wonderful family,

supporting one another in so many ways. I am excited to be a part of the Edgewood family and to be a part of your life too.

As we get to know each other, we need to share our concerns – yours with me and mine with you. That's not easy for me to do either! This month is a significant one for me. On March 2, I will be examined by Presbytery, where they will ask me questions about the Bible, polity, worship and sacraments, and theology, after which they will vote to approve my ordination as a Minister of Word and Sacrament in the PC(USA). I feel strongly that God has called me to this ministry and to ministry here at Edgewood, and I trust in God to see me the rest of the way. Yet, I am still anxious, a little nervous. Assuming all goes well at Presbytery, I will be ordained and installed during a special service on Sunday, March 17 at 4 pm, during which I will preside at my first communion service. My dad, brother, and in-laws will be here as well as friends and members from my church of care in Charlotte. And I will be sorely missing my mom, my first and most faithful cheerleader, as she passed away in 2019, after I finished my first year of seminary. This will also be my first time leading worship for Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, and Easter! The importance of these holy days and celebrating the resurrection is so essential to our faith that it


