Finding Hope in the Wilderness

We take the first steps in our Lenten journey this week on Ash Wednesday – March 5. Life seems pretty challenging right now – our family, friends, and even ourselves are struggling in the wilderness of illness or injury, political and economic uncertainty, division and conflicts, to name a few. It may feel as if we are being tested and challenged, stretched to the limits of our endurance. During the season of Lent, we remember the 40 days Jesus spent in the wilderness being tempted and the 40 years the Israelites wandered in the wilderness before arriving at the Promised Land. The wilderness is a symbolic place of challenge, struggle, difficulty, and



testing. But it is also a place of where providence finds us, growth happens, and grace abounds.

So, our theme for this Lenten season is "Finding Hope in the Wilderness." As we explore the scriptures during worship, we will look for the challenges of the text and the glimmers of hope contained therein. During our weekly Bible Study, we will look at God's Abundant Table, a devotional book by Cynthia M. Campbell* that explores the depth of meaning in the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper and how it is food for our journey, nourishment to see us through the wilderness.
